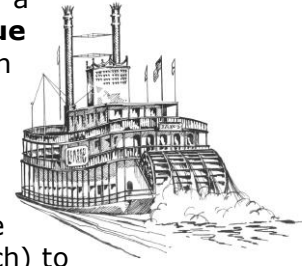
**5 DAYS July 3 - 7, 2023**

Through exhibits, multimedia experiences, and thousands of personal accounts, the Museum takes visitors on an immersive tour of World War II in every theater of war. Today's lunch and dinner are on your own and there are great options all over, in the French Quarter as well as a Mexican Restaurant adjacent to the hotel and Superior Seafood a few blocks from the hotel.

**Day Four** – Enjoy your St. Charles Inn breakfast this morning and we'll soon be traveling back to Florida, with an included lunch. The journey home continues as we travel to **Marianna FL** for a one-night stay at **Comfort Suites in Marianna FL**. The rooms here feature Coffee Maker, Iron and Board, Fridge and Microwave and Luxury Bedding.

**Day Five** – Enjoy a nice breakfast at our hotel this morning before departing for our final few destinations.
