DAY ONE – The destination for our first day of travel is **Morrow, GA**, just south of **Atlanta**, where we will have one-night at the **Drury Inn**. DAY TWO, THREE & FOUR – After Drury's great breakfast, today's travels will take us through Atlanta with views of downtown and the Capitol. Then we continue on to the **Pigeon Forge/Sevierville/Gatlinburg Tennessee area**, traveling through **The Smoky Mountain National Park**. There is a lot of beautiful mountain scenery as well as opportunity for spotting wild Elk. **The Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation** has been working to re-establish elk herds in historic ranges where the habitat and human cultural tolerance create a high potential for self-sustaining herds. Hopefully, we will spot an elk or two as we travel through the park! If time allows, we will stop at the very memorable **Newfound Gap**. It was here that President Franklin Delano Roosevelt dedicated the National Park to the American people in 1940! You'll also find a great picture taking opportunity here at a sign placed right at the state line between North Carolina and Tennessee, you can be in two states at one time! Our hotel for three nights is **Comfort Inn Apple Valley in Sevierville**. This hotel boasts both an indoor and outdoor pool, premium bedding, coffee maker, fridge and microwave in the rooms. This is a beautiful hotel in a breathtaking setting! After a bit of time to relax and recharge, we depart the hotel for tonight's fun. We will make the short drive to Pigeon Forge where we will enjoy an included dinner at **Carino's Italian**.

During our tour, we will visit neighboring **Gatlinburg** where you may want to go up the mountain on the chairlift for a bird's eye view, great for photo-taking. Or give the new **Pedestrian Sky Bridge** a try, it's

glass and will provide awesome views! You'll find breathtaking mountain views all around, a great location to view the autumn leaves. While here, you can enjoy lunch (on your own) and browse your way through town. Don't miss the Moonshine shops with sampling usually available. Then, this evening, we will enjoy a delicious, **included dinner at Applewood Farmhouse Restaurant** in nearby Sevierville, close to our hotel.

This will be a long-remembered, special day – we're going to **Dollywood!** Known for its down-home charm, this world famous 150-acre theme park is as unique as its namesake and owner Dolly Parton. From award-winning shows to educational craft demonstrations and ground-breaking rides and attractions, Dollywood offers something for everyone and every interest. Since 1986, visitors from around the world have become well acquainted with the Dollywood name and experience. However, the entertainment park traces its roots back to 1961 when Rebel Railroad first opened on the site that, over time, has expanded and grown into Dollywood. You will find terrific musical presentations throughout Dollywood, be sure to pick up a schedule and plan your day to maximize your time here. Some of Dollywood's most captivating performers don't sing or dance—they soar! Get an up-close look and some fascinating facts as these amazing birds of prey are presented at the Wings of America Birds of Prey Show featuring an impressive array of American Eagles. Truly awe-inspiring. While here, you will want to enjoy lunch or dinner, each tour member will receive a **food voucher** to use in the park, try **Aunt Granny's Buffet**, so good! You'll find a great variety of award-winning food. Experience a Smoky Mountain fall during Dollywood's Harvest Festival, voted America's #1 Fall Family Event by USA Today Readers. Soak in mountain majesty as the hills come alive with vivid color, the smells of apple and pumpkin treats waft through the streets and the sounds of our award-winning rides fill the air with adventure!
