PLUS, TWO EXCITING DAYS OF TOURING ON OUR OWN BUS WITH A LOCAL, PROFESSIONAL GUIDE. SIGHTSEEING TO INCLUDE: HISTORIC SAVANNAH AND ITS LOVELY PARK SQUARES, HISTORIC BUILDINGS FROM THE 18TH & 19TH CENTURY, VISITING THE CATHEDRAL BASILICA OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST (if available, we'll be able to go inside, \$3 donation applies), visiting the DAVENPORT HOUSE MUSEUM circa 1820, lunch included at Lady & Sons Restaurant, after lunch, free time at the historic Waterfront (River Street) along the Savannah River for shopping & browsing (dinner on your own). Our second Day in Savannah features our same local tour guide for an Atlantic Ocean Low Country Tour. This tour features views of outlying areas with river inlets, marshes & tidal creeks as we travel to Savannah's Beach at Tybee Island (we will spend some time here). Today's included lunch is at Paula Deen's Creekhouse Seafood & Grille. After lunch, also visit famous Byrd's Cookies Flagship Store, with samples. After today's tour, we will spend some time at the City Market area, a great area for shopping, browsing & (dinner on your own) with choices like: Vinnie Van Go's Go's Pizza, Belford's & more.

Day One - There is much to see as we travel through central Florida, and on up the east coast through Jacksonville and into Savannah. While here, be sure to enjoy the great beauty of the **springtime blossoms** including Dogwood, Azaleas and beautiful Camelias. Our home for the next three nights is **Springhill Suites Savannah** Airport - located just minutes from the Savannah historic districts, this hotel has many great features include: smoke-free, indoor pool, in-room coffee, large rooms with both luxury sleeping accommodations, a living/sitting area and desk too! A delicious, hot buffet breakfast is included each morning at our hotel, what a convenience.



Day Two - After our buffet breakfast, we are off for an exciting day of sightseeing with our local, professional step-on guide. We start with a Savannah "Snapshot" Tour. This tour will include the 2.2 square miles of the Historic District with exquisite ironwork, ancient cobblestones, splendid homes and churches nestled amount the gorgeous park-like squares. We'll also see an iconic symbol of Savannah, **The Cathedral Basilica of St. John the Baptist** (a small donation of \$3 is requested upon entering the cathedral, if you choose to enter). We will also tour the **Davenport House Museum**, which marked the beginning of Savannah's historic preservation movement in the mid 1990's. Today's included lunch is at

The Lady & Son's located in the City Market district. You'll fondly remember the home-style favorites served family-style at this meal. Then, this afternoon we'll spend some time along the Riverwalk with time to stroll, browse and have dinner on your own. There are a great assortment of restaurants including Huey's, The Shrimp Factory and more. A stroll down **Savannah's Riverwalk** is not only pleasing, but also truly serene. Walk along the Savannah River; stop in for a bite at any of 21 restaurants or simply enjoy the scenery as you head towards the adjoining River Street, just a short distance away. On River Street, in the heart of historic Savannah, you'll find everything from sweets to teddy bears, art galleries and restaurants housed inside restored Cotton Warehouses. The working harbor—filled with ships of all kinds, horse-drawn carriage rides and street performers add to the enticement of this idyllic waterfront locale. Eat, drink, shop and linger; there's much to see and do on River Street - a lovely oasis of shopping, dining and culture. You'll sleep great tonight; tomorrow is another big day of touring.

Day Three – After our included breakfast, the day's touring features an **Atlantic Ocean Low Country Tour**, with our local guide, on our bus. We'll enjoy the beautiful sights that showcase river inlets, marshes and tidal creeks as we travel to Savannah's Beach at **Tybee Island**. Enjoy a drive-by view of Georgia's tallest & oldest Lighthouse – guiding mariners from the Atlantic into the Savannah River for more than 270 years! We will have a stop for photos and a beach walk (if you wish) to experience the Atlantic Ocean sand & water on your toes! After the touring and enjoyment of Savannah's Beach at Tybee Island, today's **included lunch** is at **Paula Deen's Creek House Seafood & Grille**. This restaurant is nestled under the palms of Turner's Creek and offers a wide variety of Southern classics and Seafood favorites with a stunning waterfront view. This afternoon, after lunch, we'll visit the **City Market** district, known as "The art and Soul of Savannah". Since the early 1700's, City Market has been the commercial and social center of historic Savannah. Located on the original site of the market used by farmers and traders of all kinds to sell their goods and wares, City Market offers the best of what is old and new in Savannah. This charming, open-air marketplace has a wealth of things to do in Savannah whether you come for entertainment, to shop, dine or just rest your weary feet.

Day Four – Again, enjoy the hot breakfast provided at our hotel before our departure back to St. Petersburg. We'll make appropriate stops as we travel back home. We hope you have found Savannah both charming and unforgettable. Thank you for choosing **Travel Is Fun Tours** for your Savannah Tour.
