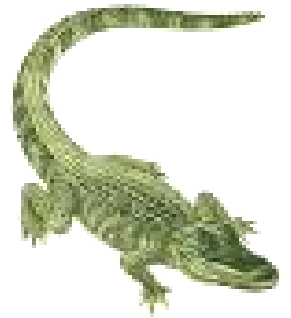

Plus a night in Ft Lauderdale, a Visit to the Miami Beach Botanical Gardens, Duck World, the Hollywood Hard Rock, Butterfly World, Seed to Table & More!!!!

Day One – We'll start with a relaxing drive throughout southern Florida, the Everglades and visiting Key West on our four-day tour! Our Lunch Stop (on your own) will be at the Naples **SEED TO TABLE** an 80,000-square-foot massive hybrid market and entertainment destination that combines vertical farming, grocery sales, and full-service dining. You'll enjoy this scenic route along the **Tamiami Trail** through authentic *old Florida*. After a short stop to visit **the Skunk Ape Research Center**, We'll make a stop at the **Ranger Station/Visitor's Center**. This is a great resource for in-depth information regarding the Everglades National Park. Another point of interest is the smallest Post Office in the United States, located near Ochopee on US Hwy 41, Zip code 34141. You may want to send a post card from this unique location. Our visit to the Keys continues as we travel through the Everglades which is known for its abundant variety of wildlife. There are hundreds of bird species, many of which are on the endangered or threatened list. You'll see a variety of large wading birds, possibly the roseate spoonbill, great blue heron, white ibis and a variety of egrets, as well as the osprey. The Everglades' marine life includes more than 200,000 alligators as well as American Crocodiles. Other wildlife in the Everglades includes the white-tailed deer as well as the endangered and elusive Florida panther. As we continue to the Keys we will pass through Key Largo, featuring the only underwater State Park. Then, on to our hotel for the next two nights, the **Fairfield Inn and Suites Marathon Florida Keys** offers guests an unforgettable tropical Middle Keys vacation. Halfway between Islamorada and Key West. Enjoy hand crafted cocktails and live local entertainment at **The Island Fish Company** (Next-door, On your Own). Do not forget to take advantage of free breakfast, Wi-Fi, fitness center, two outdoor heated pools and spacious, comfortable guest rooms with a view. Each guest room is equipped with a flat-screen TV, microwave, mini-fridge, table and chairs.

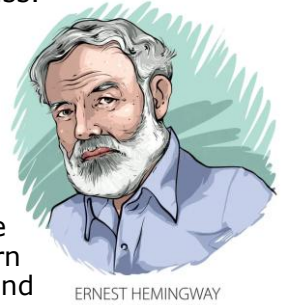


Day Two – After breakfast our day begins as we depart our hotel and begin the beautifully scenic drive to **Key West!** As we complete our journey to **Key West**, enjoy interesting narration of how all these bridges came to be. You'll also hear informative history and be shown some of the construction "secrets" of these bridges. Once we arrive in Key West our drop off point is downtown near the cruise docks, near Flagler Station. There are many things to see and do within walking distance and we are at the start of the **Old Towne Trolley Route**. On the Route you will find the famous **"Sloppy Joe's" Restaurant** and Bar, one of **Hemingway's** favorite haunts. You



may want to try local favorite **Fogarty's** with great atmosphere and indoor or outdoor seating for lunch or dinner. (on your own). Key West's first attraction, the **Aquarium** is also nearby (admission charged), originally opened in 1934. Come see the stingrays, sharks, eels and many other species. An included **On/Off Old Towne Trolley pass** will get you to all the sites you don't want to miss.

The Old Town Trolley Key West takes you to 13 stops throughout various points of interest in Key West. Another waterfront attraction you may want to experience is a **glass-bottom boat ride**. (fee applies). Throughout your day of touring Key West, you may want to line up a special restaurant for tonight's early dinner. At 7:00 PM your motorcoach will be at the prearranged location for transportation back to our hotel in Marathon for a well-earned rest. Your memories of the Keys and Key West will start to wrap up as you enjoy remnants of the gorgeous sunset as we traverse the series of bridges from Key West to Marathon. This is a real modern wonder crossing open waters of the Atlantic Ocean, Florida Bay and the Gulf of Mexico. We hope that you've enjoyed your delightful visit to Key West, the only frost-free city in the United States.

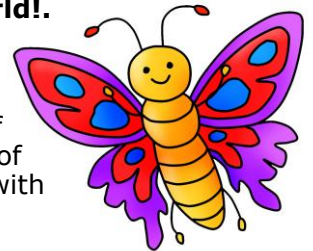
