From the "Yearling" to Gypsy Vanner Horses with lots of Cracker Country mixed in for extra Fun!!

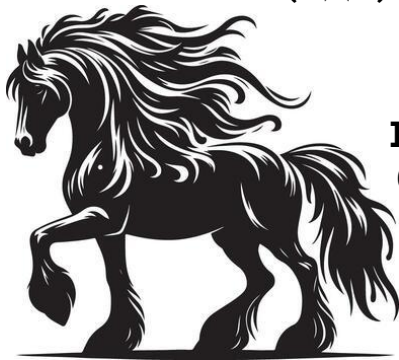

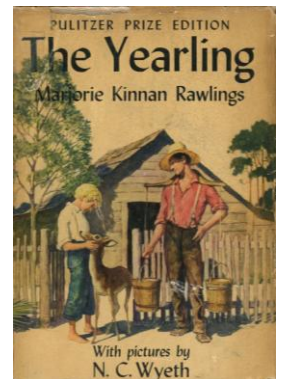
