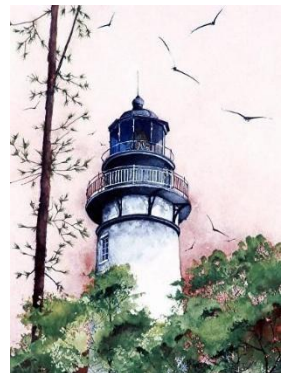

Day 1: On our first day together, we will travel directly (with appropriate stops) to Amelia Island/Fernandina Beach. We will check in to our hotel for tonight - Hampton Inn Amelia Island at Fernandina Beach Historic Harbor Front Hotel. Hampton on the House breakfast (featuring both hot and cold items) is included each morning. Our hotel is in an ideal location only one block from the cruise docks where you may enjoy lovely views of Cumberland Island. This is a very lovely hotel in a terrific location, and with our mid-afternoon arrival you'll have plenty of free time to explore. There are many shops and restaurants within walking distance of the hotel, and this evening is yours to explore and dine as you wish! There are several great dinner choices nearby including Scully's Irish Pub & Eatery for Pub Food & beverages. For an elegant evening, try The Boathouse which

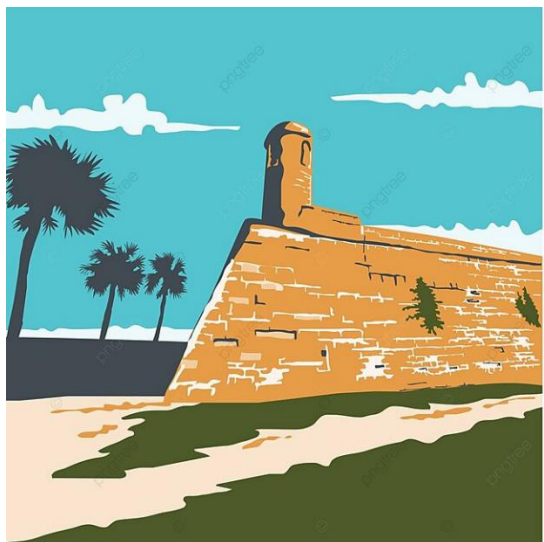
extends out over the water, Timoti's Seafood Shack is another nearby favorite, as well as the Salty Pelican with water views and a nice menu with seafood & more. Many more choices within walking distance too! After dinner we will meet back at the hotel to prepare for our evening entertainment, a lovely sunset cruise with Amelia River Cruises, after our evening cruise it's time to head off to dreamland in our comfy rooms at the Hampton Inn.

Day 2: Enjoy your **Hampton on The House** breakfast this morning, next, we will depart for our **fully narrated, guided tour** aboard the motorcoach, After our tour of Amelia Island including the lighthouse we will motor back south a bit to visit Jacksonville, Our first stop will be lunch (On Your Own) at a location offering several savory choices. After lunch we will head over to an exciting hidden secret in Jacksonville, The Sally Dark Ride Corporation. At Sally Dark Rides, we create experiences where millions of families laugh, play, and enjoy time together. Our rides are defined by unparalleled storytelling, and the memories that stem from those stories. We value those guest experiences that turn into traditions - from one generation to the next- being shared with friends and family for decades to come. On our tour we will see sculptors, painters, engineers and all the other artists working to create amazing scenery and animatronics for world-famous theme park attractions.



After lunch & our tour we will go for a driving tour of Jacksonville and explore the many bridges crossing the St John's river. After the tour we will take a short drive to St Augustine to check into our home for the next two nights – The Quality Inn/Southern Oaks Historic. This is a great location to explore St Augustine from. Just one mile from the visitors center the hotel provides a large shuttle to and from the visitor's center from 10AM to 10PM for those wishing to explore beyond the Trolley hours. Dinner tonight is n your own with many choices within easy walking distance of the hotel or all of Old Town & St George Street available using the hotel shuttle.

Day 3: After our deluxe **Breakfast**, we will take a short familiarization ride around St Augustine to point out the sights you may want to visit today. Then we will drop everybody off at the visitor center where you can make use of your all day on/off Trolley ticket to explore to your hearts content! There are many different things to see and do in St. Augustine and you will receive a detailed map of the trolley route and the attractions found at each stop. A do-not-miss attraction is the Mission of Nombre de Dios & Shrine of Our Lady of Leche. St. Augustine has many beautiful, old churches you'll want to visit. The mission has a great cross at 208 feet high. Built to commemorate the 400th Anniversary of the first parish mass. This



cross has stood for over 45 years welcoming visitors. One trolley stop features the Fountain of Youth which is across from "The Old Senator", a rather old and majestic tree at 600 years old. You may also wish to visit Ripley's Believe It or Not Museum or The Castillo de San Marcos – the oldest remaining European Fort in the United States. Another interesting attraction is the Spanish Military Hospital, take-a-peek at how patients were treated in the 1700's. Yet another place to see is the Government House & museum built by Spain – it's earliest records date back to the late 16th century. Don't miss Flagler College! This trolley also stops near The San Sebastian Winery, stop in for an informative tour and tasting. This whole day is your day to explore St. Augustine at your own pace, with you choosing what you want to see, and where you want to eat (on own). Enjoy some rest and relaxation at the Quality Inn St. Augustine tonight after your day of touring or continue into the evening taking advantage of the hotel shuttle!

Day 4: After a **Deluxe Breakfast**, it's time to start home. We will take a scenic route along the shore enjoying views of the beaches and Atlantic ocean... We will arrive around noon at world famous Disney Springs for your lunch stop. With lunch choices including House of Blues, Chef Art Smith's Homecomin, T-Rex, Rainforest Café, Planet Hollywood, Earl of Sandwich and too many more to list there is something for everyone here. We will stay for several hours giving you plenty of time to dine, shop and even ride a hot air balloon if you wish! Finally with full tummy's & shopping bags we will head back home with fond memories of our adventures and friendships we've made.
