DAY ONE – Join Travel Is fun tours for a journey you will never forget. We will depart in the morning to visit Florida's Space Coast. After a stop for lunch (on your own) at **fabulous Disney Springs** After Lunch we'll visit the American Space Museum! This is our first visit to the exciting collection! Inside **the American Space Museum**, in Downtown Titusville, you will find exhibits featuring many items donated by individuals, astronauts, space workers, NASA and space contractor companies. Our exhibit halls offer everything from spacecraft parts to astronaut suits to photos and working launch consoles. We even have Soviet Space Program memorabilia. Space View Park honors the space program with monuments, mission plaques and bronze handprints of six of the original seven astronauts. The Mercury, Gemini, Apollo, and Shuttle monuments are dedicated to the workers and astronauts of these space programs. We will then depart for our home for tonight, **The Titusville Comfort Inn**. Our hotel has a nice variety of restaurant choices nearby for your evening meal including Durango Steakhouse, Popeyes or Cracker Barrel. (Dinner not included), For those of you who want some more sightseeing we'll take the bus to Cocoa Beach with a stop at **Cocoa Beach Surf Company** which has the Shark Pit Bar & Grill for your dining pleasure. Right next door is the world-famous original **Ron Jon Surf shop** for your souvenir & T-shirt needs!

DAY TWO – After an included hot/cold breakfast at our hotel we take off to our destination – **The Kennedy Space Center!** Our visit should be from 9 am to 5 pm.

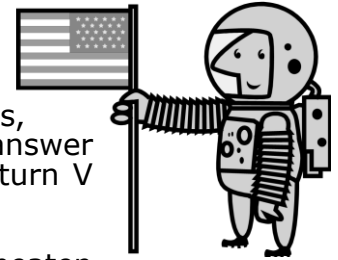
Space Shuttle Atlantis Exhibit – After entering the building between two full-size solid rocket boosters & the shuttles External Tank prepare for a lump in your throat as you are presented the Shuttle Atlantis in a dynamic in-flight pose. Make sure to try the Shuttle Launch Experience ride (a gentle ride for just about anybody) check out the Hubble Telescope mockup & much more!

Kennedy Space Center bus tour – Visit the gargantuan Vehicle Assembly Building, LC39 Observation Gantry, Pad 39B, the gigantic tractor that moved the Saturn Vs to the Pad & finally stop at the Saturn V Exhibit.

Saturn V Building – Gaze up in wonder as you stroll under the stages of what would have been Apollo 18. See the Lunar Module, Astronauts Space Suits, Kennedy Mission Control, and a Lunar Rover, Touch a real moon rock & much more! There is a very nice cafeteria at this location if all your exploration has you ready for a bite to eat! When you are done at the Saturn V exhibit the friendly Kennedy Space Center bus driver will return you to the visitor's center. On your way back, you may see an Eagles nest, possibly manatees & alligators too!

Artemis - The Artemis program is NASA's initiative to establish a long-term human presence on the Moon, with its first mission, Artemis I, successfully launched in 2022, followed by the manned Artemis II mission slated for 2025. The program utilizes the powerful Space Launch System (SLS) rocket and the Orion spacecraft, which carry astronauts on lunar missions, with the goal of landing the first woman and person of color on the Moon. A key component is the lunar Gateway, a planned space station in lunar orbit that will serve as a staging point for surface missions.

Kennedy Visitor's Center – Here, you can wrap up your day. Visit the IMAX Theater for an outstanding look at the International Space Station or the Hubble Space Telescope. Go to any of the informative space exploration exhibits to learn about the history of America's most exciting period. Finally, visit the gift shop for out of this world gifts & mementos, also the Gift shop *usually* has an actual astronaut in the upstairs section to answer questions & sign autographs. And if you didn't get your lunch at the Saturn V building there are several very nice restaurants at the visitors' center.



DAY THREE: This Morning we will visit **Wild Florida!** Travel down the unbeaten path to get up close and personal with wildlife from all over the world, right from the comfort of your own Motor Coach! Our **Drive-thru Safari** travels down four miles of dirt terrain, so you can see native and exotic animals, typically only seen on TV. The fun doesn't stop after your excursion! Just outside the Drive-thru Safari trail, get face to face with our **giraffe family members and feed them!** In our **Gator Park**, we have over **200 animals** on display, including exotic animals like **zebras, sloths, lemurs, capybaras and Watusi**, just to name a few. We have a walk-in bird aviary with pheasants, parrots, and other birds from all over the world. Our animal keepers are very knowledgeable about the habits and history of the animals in our **Gator Park**. Ask your agent at **Travel is Fun** about scheduling a **close encounter** with one of your **favorite critters** while we're there or a spin on one of their **airboats!** While you are feasting on all this natural beauty, we have something to delight another one of your senses.
