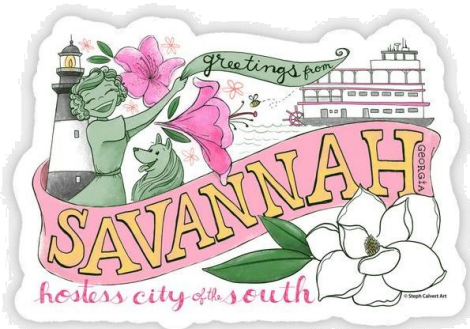

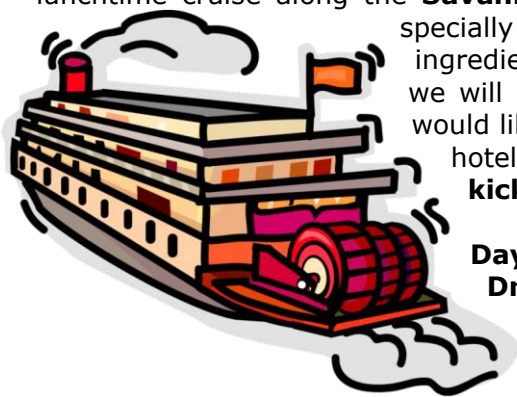

After our trip to the Lighthouse, we'll head for a fantastic Buffet lunch at the **Pirate House!** Savor an authentic taste of the South



at the **legendary Pirates' House**, one of Savannah's most historic and beloved restaurants, the **Southern Lunch Buffet** features classic favorites like award-winning fried chicken, fried fish, creamy macaroni and cheese, mashed potatoes with gravy, collard greens, green beans, and homemade dessert. Housed in a **landmark dating back to 1753**, The Pirates' House pairs delicious Southern comfort food with fascinating pirate lore and colonial charm, making it a memorable dining experience for visitors of all ages. Finally, after the Pirate House, we'll pay a visit to another Savannah Landmark – **The Mercer-Williams house**. Step inside one of Savannah's most iconic historic homes at the Mercer Williams House Museum. Overlooking picturesque **Monterey Square**, this stunning Italianate mansion was originally **designed in 1860** and is renowned for its exquisite architecture, elegant antiques, fine art collection, and beautifully restored interiors. The home gained international fame through **Midnight in the Garden of Good and Evil**, but its guided tours focus on the property's rich architectural history, preservation, and the remarkable legacy of restorationist Jim Williams. A visit offers a fascinating glimpse into Savannah's history, artistry, and timeless Southern elegance. After our day of touring, we'll go back to the **Drury Plaza** in plenty of time to enjoy your cocktails & snacks at the **5:30 kickback!**



Day Three – Again, enjoy the hot breakfast provided at our hotel before we return to Downtown Savannah for some more free time this Morning – We'll do a short driving tour then drop off along the **riverwalk** to allow some sightseeing & shopping before our **Thanksgiving Cruise!** The Riverfront area is where former Cotton Warehouses, known as Factor's Walk, are now being utilized as restaurants, hotels and shops. A stroll down **Savannah's Riverwalk** is not only pleasing, but also truly serene. Walk along the **Savannah River**; stop in for a snack at any of many restaurants or simply enjoy the scenery as you head towards the adjoining River Street, just a short distance away. On **River Street**, in the heart of historic Savannah, you'll find everything from sweets to teddy bears, art galleries and restaurants housed inside restored Cotton Warehouses. The working harbor—filled with ships of all kinds, horse-drawn carriage rides and street performers add to the enticement of this idyllic waterfront locale. For our Thanksgiving Feast today we will board **Savannah Riverboat Cruises** for a scenic and delicious lunchtime cruise along the **Savannah River** aboard a majestic old-fashioned paddle-wheeler! Enjoy a specially prepared buffet-style Thanksgiving Meal made with the freshest, local ingredients that has something to satisfy everyone's palate! After the cruise we will head back to the Drury for a relaxing afternoon and evening.
